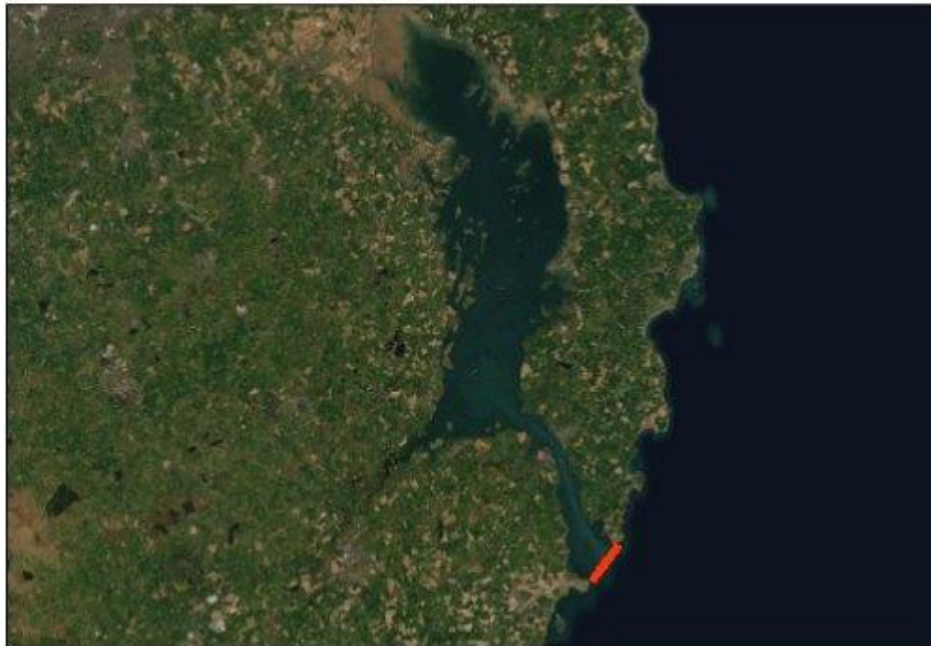


# Northern Ireland Marine Disease Control Compartments - Strangford Lough as of 10 Dec 2019
