Key trends



The average **NI prime cattle price** was up 28.7p/kg to 453.6p/kg in September 2023. This was a 6.8 per cent increase from September 2022.



The average NI cow price increased by 31.3p/kg in September this year.



Across the regions the **R3 steer price** increased by 31.3p/kg in NI, 40.4p/kg in GB and declined by the equivalent of 11.5p/kg in ROI when compared to the same period last year.



NI prime cattle throughput declined by 2,342 head in September 2023 with 26872 prime cattle processed locally. Cow throughput decreased by 380 head, back 4.1 per cent from September 2022. Average carcase weights were back by 4.4kg for prime cattle and were back by 7.8kg for cows.



Imports for direct slaughter were up over 54 per cent in September 2023 compared to the same period in 2022. Exports for direct slaughter totalled 25 head in September 2023, back 239 head from September 2022.

Calf registrations in September 2023 were back 3,563 head or 13.4 per cent when compared to the same period in 2022. Beef sired calf registrations increased by 11.5 per cent from September 2022 levels while dairy male calf registrations were back 24.5 per cent or by 962 head.
