

#### **Deadweight Cattle Trade**

NI factory base quotes for U-3 grade steers and heifers strengthened at the start of last week to a range of 466-476p/kg with a similar range expected early next week. Base quotes for 0+3 cows also increased to a range of 355-375p/kg last Monday, with quotes expected to remain firm going into next week.

Last week, a total of 6,821 prime animals and 2,538 cows were presented for slaughter in local plants. Imports of cattle to NI for direct slaughter totalled 416 steers, 41 heifers and 223 cows meanwhile, only four cows were exported from NI for direct slaughter in ROI last week.


The deadweight cattle trade strengthened for the most part in NI with average steers, heifers and young bulls reporting average category increases of 0.7p/kg, 3.3p/kg and 5.7p/kg respectively. The young bulls category reported the largest increases ranging from 1p/kg up to 8p/kg last week. However, cow trade weakened by 1.7p/kg to an average paid price of 319.4p/kg in NI.

In ROI, deadweight cattle trade strengthened across the board in euro terms however, there were some declines reported for prime cattle in sterling terms last week. A marginal increase of 0.1p/kg was recorded for R3 steers, meanwhile R3 heifers and young bulls reported a decline of 1.1p/kg and 0.7p/kg respectively. Trade for 03 cows strengthened by 3.3p/kg in ROI last week.

Across the water, in GB, the deadweight cattle trade strengthened with the average steers, heifers, young bulls and cows reporting increases of 3p/kg, 4.5p/kg, 2.8p/kg and 3.5p/kg respectively.

Base quotes for R3 grade lambs started last week at 600p/kg with quotes of 595-605p/kg expected early next week, with only one plant quoting the lower price. Last week, a total of 9,952 lambs were processed locally and 5,046 lambs were exported to ROI for direct slaughter. Lamb exports to GB for direct slaughter came to a halt last week, after 15 consecutive weeks of lambs being transported across the Irish sea. The average price paid for R3 lambs continues above previous years, with an average price of 611.1p/kg paid in NI last week, back 10.6p/kg from the week previous. However, liveweight lamb trade in NI strengthened by 6.5p/kg to an average price of 555.0p/kg last week. A marginal increase of 0.7p/kg was reported for deadweight lambs in GB, meanwhile the ROI lamb trade decreased by 4.9p/kg last week.
