### Deadweight Cattle Trade

A record trade was reported for prime cattle in NI plants last week, surpassing the previous peak in the local deadweight prime cattle trade reported during 2023. The average price paid for R3 steers peaked at 496.4p/kg with R4 steers paid 498.5p/kg on average. The average price paid for O3 steers and heifers in NI also reached a new high last week reported at 490.7p/kg and 486.7p/kg respectively. The average price paid for steers overall was up 2.3p/kg on the previous week with increases across the category ranging from 1.4 - 7.9p/kg. The trade for heifers in NI last week strengthened 1.2p/kg to 489.8p/kg while the R3 heifer price reported a marginal decline (-0.1p/kg) to 494.8p/kg. The cow trade in NI last week reported a strengthening of 2.2p/kg to an average of 322.2p/kg despite the O3 cow price reporting a 3p/kg decline to 363.4p/kg.

Imports of ROI cattle for direct slaughter locally continue at high levels. Last week prime cattle imports totalled 608 head, with 346 cows also imported. Slaughterings in local plants last week comprised of 8,613 prime cattle, and 2,658 cows. Base quotes received from six of the seven major NI plants indicate a similar trade early next week. Industry continues to report strong supplies of cattle coming forward for slaughter in line with normal seasonal trends. However, the level of finish continues to be reported as a challenge when sourcing cattle. This creates opportunity for those producers selling in-spec cattle to price around the plants and maximise returns.

Last week in GB the R3 steer price was 520p/kg and the equivalent of 425.8p/kg in R0I.

#### **Sheep Trade**

Early next week, the local deadweight trade for lambs is expected to strengthen with base quotes of 600 - 610p/kg received from the major plants. Throughput in local plants remains strong with 10,872 lambs slaughtered last week. Meanwhile, an additional 4,706 lambs were exported to ROI last week for direct slaughter.

In local marts this week a strong demand from the export market drove a firm trade, while store lambs were also met with a brisk trade in marts across the country.

DAERA reported a differential of 29.2p/kg between the live and deadweight sheep trade in NI last week versus a difference of 41p/kg a fortnight prior. The average liveweight lamb price in NI last week was up 10p/kg on the previous week to 557.8p/kg, with the average deadweight price up 2p/kg from the previous week to 587p/kg.

In ROI last week the deadweight trade for lambs reported an increase the equivalent of 5.1p/kg to 605.9p/kg. Next week the deadweight trade for lambs in ROI is expected to strenghten further.
