



### **Deadweight Cattle Trade**

Last week in NI prime cattle throughput remained steady on the previous week with 7,932 head processed, while the local cow kill recorded a decline of 194 head to total 1,954 head. Fewer ROI origin cattle were imported for direct slaughter locally last week. Steer and heifer imports totalled 286 head and 129 cows, a difference of 101 prime cattle and 10 cows on the previous week. Meanwhile, 15 cows were exported to ROI for direct slaughter.

Significant increases in deadweight cattle prices were reported across the board in NI last week with the average price paid for steers, heifers and young bulls increasing 2.3p/kg, 2.8p/kg and 2.1p/kg respectively. R3 grade steers and heifers reported increases of 1.1/kg and 1p/kg respectively. Cows saw the greatest improvements week on week up 10.5p/kg on average to 312.6p/kg, with the average price paid for an 03 cow up 3.6p/kg to 346.3p/kg. Next week a further strengthening in trade is expected with plants providing increased base quotes for all types of cattle.

The deadweight trade for all types of cattle stabilised in ROI last week in euro terms, however a slight weakening in euro against sterling has meant the majority of reported prices were back in sterling terms. In GB a mixed trade was reported for prime cattle while cows saw improved prices across all regions.



## **Sheep Trade**

The liveweight sheep trade reported a recovery in local marts mid-week with GB buyers sourcing lambs in NI. This follows a week of fewer NI lamb/hogget exports to ROI with just shy of 1,200 head exported last week. With increased supplies available domestically, NI plants offered reduced quotes for all types of sheep this week. However, the stronger trade and improved demand reported on Wednesday afternoon, and exports to ROI expected to recover to stronger levels next week, has seen preliminary quotes received for early next week recovering to 730p/kg for hoggets and 780p/kg for spring lambs.
