Deadweight Cattle Trade

Base quotes in from NI plants this week for in spec U-3 grading prime cattle remained steady at 460-468p/kg. Producers should use these quotes as a starting point for negotiation with higher prices available, particularly for cattle that meet current market specifications. Meanwhile, the cow trade increased mid-week with quotes of 330-356p/kg offered for good quality 0+3 grading cows.

Prime cattle slaughterings in local plants last week totalled 6,654 head, back 1,278 head from the week previous, while the local cow kill remained steady with a total of 1,898 processed last week. Cattle imports for direct slaughter from ROI reported an increase in numbers last week with a total of 325 prime cattle and 150 cows imported. Meanwhile, five prime cattle and 14 cows were exported to ROI for direct slaughter.

Prime cattle trade continued to strengthen in NI last week with average prices paid for steers, heifers and young bulls up 1.3p/kg, 0.3p/kg and 4p/kg respectively. However, cow trade on the other hand reported declines across all grades last week, bringing the average price paid for cows back 4.8p/kg to 307.8p/kg. Cattle trade in ROI strengthened in sterling terms last week with R3 grading steers, heifers and young bulls up 1.7p/kg, 2.4p/kg and 1.4p/kg respectively, as well as O3 grading cows up 0.7p/kg. Prime cattle trade came under some pressure in GB, meanwhile cow trade strengthened across the regions, with GB reporting an increase of 3.4p/kg on average for 03 grading cows.

Sheep Trade

Deadweight sheep trade softened further with another week of low levels of NI sheep exports to ROI for direct slaughter however, there were 575 hoggets/lambs transported to GB for direct slaughter last week. Deadweight R3 grade hoggets were back 30.7 p/kg to 745.1 p/kg and R3 grade spring lambs were also back 23.2p/kg to 796.6p/kg. A decline in sheep trade was also evident in GB last week with lambs paying 6.5p/kg less than the week previous and in ROI, deadweight sheep trade reported a decline of 7.4p/kg to an average paid price of 777.7p/kg.

Last week, the liveweight hogget trade decreased by 21.3p/kg to an average paid price of 619.3p/kg, meanwhile liveweight spring lamb trade recovered by 13.9p/kg to an average paid price of 754.5p/kg. Increased numbers of spring lambs passed through the sale rings with a stronger trade reported last week. In Ballymena, 1,140 spring lambs sold at a price range of 760-907p/kg (avg 810p/kg) compared to 600 spring lambs sold at a price range of 750-886p/kg (avg 780p/kg) the week previous. In Armoy last week, 212 spring lambs sold from 840-878p/kg compared to 75 spring lambs at a price range of 750-830p/kg the week previous. The ewe trade continues at strong levels across NI marts with a top price of £280 reported for a fat ewe
