### Key trends



In the w/e 03/05/20 the average R3 heifer price in the EU was 349.7c/kg, a decrease of 7.7c/kg from 357.5c/kg in the w/e 05/04/20.



NI moved up to sixth place in the EU league table with the equivalent price of 372.6c/kg. This was despite a 4.6c/kg decrease from the 377.2c/kg paid during the w/e 05/04/20. The differential between the R3 heifer price in NI and the EU average widened from 19.7c/kg to 22.9c/kg in the w/e 03/05/20.



GB retained fifth position on the league table with an equivalent R3 heifer price of 374.5c/kg, a 6.7c/kg decrease from the 381.3c/kg paid in the w/e 05/04/20. The differential between GB and the EU average slightly widened from 23.8c/kg to 24.8c/kg in the w/e 03/05/20.



In ROI the R3 heifer price was 347.3c/kg in the w/e 03/05/20, a decrease of 11.3c/kg from the w/e 05/04/20. This placed it in ninth position in the league table, 2.4c/kg below the EU average price and 25.3c/kg lower than the same price in NI.



The euro decreased to €1= 87.2p in the w/e 03/05/20.
