### Key trends



In the w/e 05/07/20 the average R3 heifer price in the EU was 362.7c/kg, an increase of 0.7c/kg from 362.0c/kg in the w/e 07/06/20.



NI moved up to third place in the EU league table with the equivalent price of 403.2c/kg. This was a 6.2c/kg increase from the 397.0c/kg paid during the w/e 07/06/20. The differential between the R3 heifer price in NI and the EU average widened from 35.0c/kg to 40.5c/kg in the w/e 05/07/20.



GB moved up to second position on the league table with an equivalent R3 heifer price of 403.3c/kg, a 2.7c/kg increase from the 400.6c/kg paid in the w/e 07/06/20. The differential between GB and the EU average widened from 38.6c/kg to 40.6c/kg in the w/e 05/07/20.



In ROI the R3 heifer price was 365.7c/kg in the w/e 05/07/20, a decrease of 0.9c/kg from the w/e 07/06/20. This placed it in seventh position in the league table, 3.0c/kg above the EU average price and 37.5c/kg lower than the same price in NI.



The euro increased to €1= 90.7p in the w/e 05/07/20.
