### Key trends



In the w/e 26/07/20 the average R3 heifer price in the EU was 364.9c/kg, an increase of 1.2c/kg from 363.7c/kg in the w/e 28/06/20.



NI moved up to second place in the EU league table with the equivalent price of 408.1c/kg. This was a 7.5c/kg increase from the 400.5c/kg paid during the w/e 28/06/20. The differential between the R3 heifer price in NI and the EU average widened from 36.8c/kg to 43.2c/kg in the w/e 26/07/20.



GB moved down to fourth position on the league table with an equivalent R3 heifer price of 402.0c/kg, a decrease of 3.9c/kg from the 405.9c/kg paid in the w/e 28/06/20. The differential between GB and the EU average narrowed from 42.2c/kg to 37.1c/kg in the w/e 26/07/20.



In ROI the R3 heifer price was 376.4c/kg in the w/e 26/07/20, an increase of 11.4c/kg from the w/e 28/06/20. This placed it in sixth position in the league table, 11.5c/kg above the EU average price and 31.7c/kg lower than the same price in NI.



The euro increased to €1= 90.8p in the w/e 26/07/20.
