Deadweight Cattle Trade

The deadweight cattle trade continued to improve across NI, GB and ROI last week. In NI, the average price paid for a U3 steer and heifer was 519.4p/kg and 521.3p/kg, up by 3.9p/kg and 5.1p/kg respectively from the previous week. The average price paid for steers overall strengthened 2.2p/kg to 509.5p/kg, while the average price paid for heifers increased by 6.7p/kg to 511.1p/kg. The U3 young bull price also reported a 2.2p/kg increase last week, despite the overall young bull price softening 0.9p/kg to 487p/kg. The trade for cows in NI continued to strengthen for the sixth consecutive week with the average cow price up by 5.3p/kg to 340.8p/kg.

In GB last week all reported base grades strengthened week on week with U3 steers and heifers increasing by 3.5p/kg and 3.7p/kg to 559.3p/kg and 561.3p/kg respectively. The average price paid for an O3 cow surpassed 400p/kg for the first time during 2024. Similarly, in ROI the trade continued to strengthen for all types of cattle in both euro and sterling terms.

Cattle throughput in local plants increased last week with 8,063 prime cattle and 2,848 cows slaughtered. Imports of prime cattle from ROI for direct slaughter declined by 164 head on the previous week to total 236 head. Direct slaughter cow imports continued at a steady level last week with 252 cows imported. No prime cattle travelled from NI to ROI last week for direct slaughter, while 39 cows were exported. Meanwhile, a widening disparity between NI and GB cattle prices, saw 40 cattle exported to GB for direct slaughter last week, the first consignment of cattle to leave NI for a mainland plant since week ending 29 April 2023. Last week's shipment comprised of 31 steers, six heifers, one young bull, one calf and a cow.

Sheep Trade

This week base quotes for R3 lambs continued to strengthen, with plants quoting 670-680p/kg mid week up to 23kg. Preliminary quotes of 680p/kg have been received from the three major processing plants for Monday's kill. Last week, lamb throughput in local plants totalled 8,992 head, an increase of 140 head week on week. The average deadweight lamb price locally remained steady on the previous week at 662.5p/kg. In GB, despite the average deadweight lamb price reporting a decline of 0.8p/kg to 689.9p/kg last week, 279 NI lambs were exported to GB for direct slaughter.

ROI remains a strong source of demand for NI sheep with the ROI trade strengthening by the equivalent of 9.1p/kg to an average of 683.7p/g last week. In turn a strong live trade was reported across local marts with the average price up 1.7p/kg week on week to 637p/kg. Last week 4.380 lambs were exported to ROI for direct slaughter.
