Who will this consultation be of most interest to?
Producers of Raw Drinking Milk (RDM) in England, Wales, Northern Ireland and other stakeholders.

What is the subject of this consultation?
The proposed appeal process whereby RDM producers may challenge the inspection ratings, which are due to be made publicly available for the first time alongside a list of registered RDM producers on the FSA website.

What is the purpose of this consultation?
The purpose of the consultation is to seek RDM producers' and other stakeholders' views on the key elements of the draft appeal proposal and the timing of publication of inspection compliance ratings.
The provision of an appeals process is to ensure that RDM producers have an opportunity to challenge the compliance ratings of official control inspections before the results are published and is in line with the provisions of the Regulators' Code.

Publication of Food Standards Agency Raw Drinking Milk producer compliance ratings in England, Wales and Northern Ireland

DETAIL OF CONSULTATION

Introduction

Following discussions in July 2015 on the Review of Controls for Raw Drinking Milk (RDM)¹, the Food Standards Agency (FSA) Board agreed to publish a list of registered RDM producers (selling unpasteurised milk direct to the final consumer) within England, Wales and Northern Ireland, alongside their compliance ratings arising from official control inspections. The purpose of this is to enable consumers to make informed decisions in relation to the purchase and consumption of RDM. This is consistent with the level of information available to consumers in other sectors (such as caterers and slaughterhouses).

The compliance ratings that may be awarded are:

- Good
- Generally Satisfactory
- Improvement Necessary
- Urgent Improvement Necessary

It is envisaged that publishing a list of RDM producers and their compliance ratings will draw attention to and increase Food Business Operators' (FBO) compliance with the regulatory framework. As inspection ratings will be made publicly available, it is appropriate that FBOs are given the opportunity to challenge the compliance ratings of official control inspections through the establishment of an inspection appeal process. This is also consistent with the provisions in the Regulators' Code² that there should be an impartial and clearly explained route for businesses to appeal decisions made by the regulator.

Proposal: Notification, publication and appeal of inspection compliance rating

Inspections will be undertaken following the current established procedures. Since its introduction across the whole sector in June of 2015 RDM producers in England and Wales should already be familiar with the compliance rating scheme for dairy premises. At the conclusion of the post-inspection meeting, the Dairy Hygiene Inspector (DHI) discusses their findings with the RDM producer or their authorised representative.

- The compliance rating for those premises identified as gaining a rating of 'Good' will be published on the FSA website on completion of the FSA's internal verification procedures.

- FBOs with ratings of Generally Satisfactory, Improvement Necessary or Urgent Improvement Necessary will be entitled to appeal within 21 calendar days from receipt of the inspection report by using the procedures outlined in annex A and using the 'Request for a Review of the Compliance Rating of Establishments Producing Raw Drinking Milk' form. If, after 21 calendar days, no appeal request has been received by the FSA, the FSA will publish the compliance rating outcomes for all other premises.

Key proposal(s):

- **Introduction of a producer appeal process.**
- **Premises' with ratings of 'Good' published on completion of FSA internal verification procedures.**
- **Other ratings to be published following a 21 day period during which producers may appeal against the inspection findings.**
- **Where an appeal has been submitted, the rating will be published at the conclusion of the appeal.**

Engagement and Consultation Process

Since its introduction across the whole sector in June of 2015 RDM producers within England and Wales should already be familiar with the compliance rating scheme for dairy premises, having already had at least one inspection under this scheme and the opportunity to discuss with the Inspector. The sale of RDM is relatively new in NI. There are currently 3 producers; 2 of whom have started up in the last year.

Stakeholders have also received communications on the FSA Board decision to publish a list of registered producers due to the clear public health interest in consumers knowing how to find a registered supplier of RDM. Following consultation with interested parties, the list of producers was published on 1 March 2016. This also informed stakeholders of the intention to publish inspection compliance ratings following this consultation inviting stakeholder comments.

Following this consultation, comments will be evaluated and utilized to provide necessary adjustments to the appeal process before implementation.

Questions asked in this consultation:

Q1: Is it acceptable for 'GOOD' ratings to be published immediately following internal verification?

Q2: Does the timescale of 21 calendar days provide sufficient time to lodge the appeal.

Q3: Is the process of appeal transparent and easy to follow? If not, how could it be improved?

ANNEX A (Information for Food Business operators)

Raw Drinking Milk Compliance Rating Appeals Procedure

If you require clarification of the inspection findings please contact the Dairy Hygiene Inspector who carried out the inspection in the first instance. **This is not part of the appeal and does not change the deadline for lodging an appeal** (Any reference to numbers of 'days', includes weekends and bank holidays).

If you are still dissatisfied with the compliance rating assessment made for your raw drinking milk production establishment, you may appeal the inspection rating via the process detailed below.

Appeals

The Food Business Operator (FBO) should complete the form 'Request for a Review of the Compliance Rating of Establishments Producing Raw Drinking Milk', which can be downloaded from the Food Standards Agency web site (<http://www.food.gov.uk/TBC>) or requested by emailing:

Executive.Support@foodstandards.gsi.gov.uk 028 90 417700 for Northern Ireland.

Completed forms should be returned to the FSA's Business Support team either by post to the appropriate address on the form, to (Business.Support@foodstandards.gsi.gov.uk) for England and Wales or Executive.Support@foodstandards.gsi.gov.uk for Northern Ireland within 21 calendar days of the initial inspection and receipt of the report following the conclusion of the inspection. (Day one is when the inspection report was delivered by hand or within two days' of posting by first class)

The FBO or nominated representative should include objective evidence that the assessment by the Dairy Hygiene Inspector (DHI) is incorrect.

Upon receipt, the FSA's Head of Field Operations (Head of Operational Policy and Delivery in Northern Ireland) will appoint an Investigating Officer (IO) to consider the evidence objectively and impartially to determine the outcome of the appeal. The IO will be from outside the DHI's line management chain, with suitable experience to carry out an objective and impartial review of the evidence. In line with the Regulators' Code, the DHI who conducted the inspection will not be involved in determining their decision on the review, but the IO will liaise with the FBO and the DHI to consider their evidence. The IO will review the Inspection records and appeal reasons identified on this form against the compliance standards set out in the FSA operational procedures and guidance.

The IO's decision will be based on the written evidence and supporting documents provided and assessed against the guidance for application of compliance ratings. Where it is not possible for the IO to reach a decision based on the documentation, an unannounced visit to the establishment may be required, either by the IO (or delegated to a suitable officer for the purpose of evidence gathering only).

The IO will complete the review of the inspection report within a further 21 calendar days from receipt of the appeal and communicate their decision in writing. The decision will be sent to the FBO (or their nominated representative), the Dairy Hygiene Inspector and the FSA Head of Field Operations (Head of Operational Policy and Delivery in Northern Ireland).

Where the IO determines that the compliance rating awarded should be amended, they will inform the Dairy Hygiene Inspector so that an adjustment can be made to the inspection report. An amended inspection report will then be issued to the FBO.

The compliance rating on the FSA's website will be shown as 'awaiting publication' until the appeal is concluded.

The Investigating Officer's decision is final. When the appeal is concluded, the FSA's website will be updated with the final rating.

Review Procedure:

- Food Business Operators (FBOs) wishing to request a review of the most recent compliance inspection must complete this form and return it to the appropriate address below within 21 calendar days of receipt of the initial inspection report (day one is when the inspection report was delivered by hand or within two days' of posting)
- The request should include objective evidence to support your view that the assessment by the Dairy Hygiene Inspector has been incorrectly awarded.
- The FSA Head of Field Operations (Head of Operational Policy and Delivery in Northern Ireland) will appoint an Investigating Officer (IO) with suitable experience to carry out an objective and impartial review of the evidence.
- The IO will liaise with the FBO (or their nominated representative) and the Dairy Hygiene Inspector (DHI) who conducted the inspection being appealed in determining their decision on the review. The IO will confine their review to the assessment identified on this form.
- The decision by the IO will be based on the written evidence and supporting documents provided. Where it is not possible for the IO to reach a decision based on the documentation, an unannounced visit to the establishment may be required. The IO will conduct the review of the inspection report and communicate their decision in writing to the FBO (or their nominated representative), the DHI and the FSA Head of Field Operations (Head of Operational Policy and Delivery in Northern Ireland) within 21 calendar days of receipt of the appeal.
- Where the IO determines that the compliance rating should be amended, they will inform the Dairy Hygiene Inspector to ensure an adjustment is made to the inspection report. The amended inspection report will then be issued to the FBO (or their nominated representative).
- The compliance rating will not be published until the appeal is concluded and the FBO and DHI have been informed of the outcome of the review.
