
1. Building On Previous Consultations

Key findings from the responses;



SAMPLE QUOTES

- 1. 'Public space creates a welcoming, vibrant atmosphere in the city and provides a natural meeting place for people of different backgrounds, which contributes to social cohesion and mental wellbeing."
- 2. 'Good provision of public transport and public space is vital in having an equal society that is fair to all."
- 3. 'It should help to make public transport more appealing to those working in the city and reduce the demand for parking."
- 4. The ability to grow and improve the number of trains from hourly to a more frequent service is vital to a modern economy."
- 5. 'Open up more opportunities for the younger generation to travel."
- 6. 'More integrated transport system will be more inclusive for economic dependants, such as the elderly, who may not be able to afford private car transport. The new system will allow greater flexibility and improve their mobility."
- 7. 'Station Square: Opportunity to create good first impression of Belfast for arriving visitors, tourists, business commuters etc.'














2. Masterplan Vision

The masterplan vision is for a vibrant, mixed use extension to the city offering 120,000 sq.m of contemporary residential apartments, high quality office space and significant new retail, leisure and community facilities at ground floor level.

As well as general streetscape and public realm enhancements, The Hub proposals include a major new public square of 4,000 sq/m.



Diagram 1 - Belfast Hub will be at the heart of a new 'Station Quarter' and will be a major catalyst in the regeneration of the site and surrounding area.





Diagram 2 - The development of the Hub, masterplan and the public realm is rooted in the local context; from geography, urban character,








5. Public Realm



The major focus of the development will be a significant new public square with public art, planting, water features and terraced seating

Scale comparison: Station Square (Above) - Custom House Square, Belfast (below)







- . The paving patterns are inspired by the local linen weaving




