
## **GrassCheck**

## Management notes.

- Grass growth is declining as autumn progresses, but still remains well above the seasonal average and this trend is predicted to continue over the next 2 weeks.
- Grass quality on the plots has improved, both in terms of ME and sugars,
  reflecting the better weather of late. CP is typically high at this time of year.
- Make the most of improving ground conditions to get swards grazed out. Start with drier fields, adopt a flexible grazing approach to minimise poaching and sward damage.
- Once these swards are grazed out, do not re-graze, as this allows some grass to build up for early spring grazing next year.
