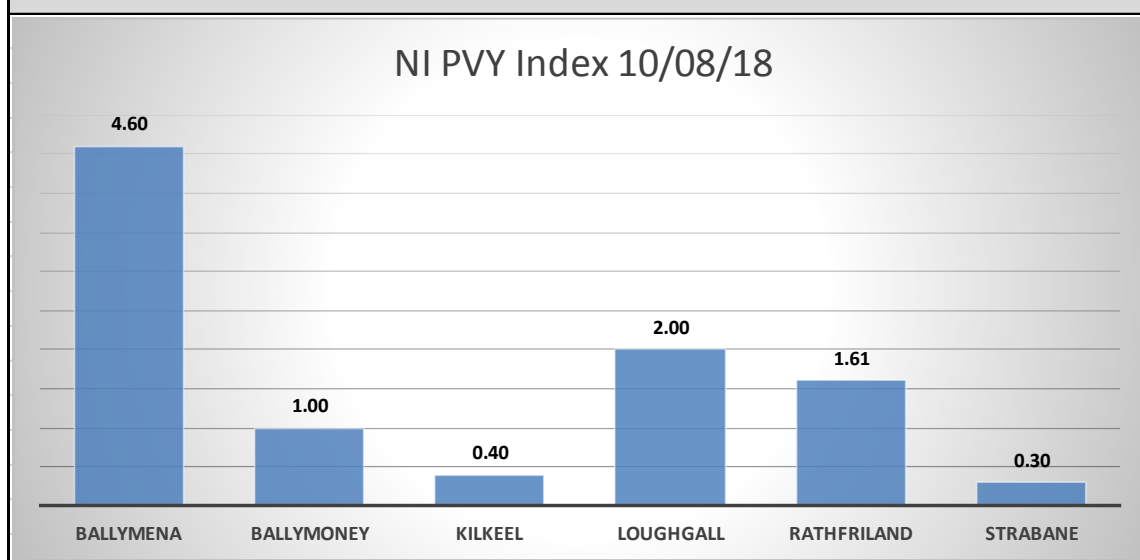

Ballymena	Moderate risk: 3 <i>Rhopalosiphum padi</i> (Bird Cherry-Oat Aphid), 1 <i>Sitobion avenae</i> (Grain Aphid), 11 <i>Macrosiphum euphorbiae</i> (Potato Aphid) and 2 <i>Metopolophium dirhodum</i> (Rose-Grain Aphid) recorded at this site.	
Ballymoney	Low risk: 1 <i>Rhopalosiphum padi</i> (Bird Cherry-Oat Aphid) and <i>Metopolophium dirhodum</i> (Rose-Grain Aphid) recorded at this site.	
Kilkeel	Low risk: 2 <i>Macrosiphum euphorbiae</i> (Potato Aphid) recorded at this site.	
Loughgall	Low risk: 1 <i>Rhopalosiphum padi</i> (Bird Cherry-Oat Aphid), 1 <i>Acyrtosiphon pisum</i> (Pea Aphid), 1 <i>Macrosiphum euphorbiae</i> (Potato Aphid), 2 <i>Metopolophium dirhodum</i> (Rose-Grain Aphid) and 1 recorded at this site.	
Rathfriland	Low risk: 1 <i>Acyrtosiphon pisum</i> (Pea Aphid), 2 <i>Macrosiphum euphorbiae</i> (Potato Aphid), 1 <i>Metopolophium dirhodum</i> (Rose-Grain Aphid), 2 <i>Aphis fabae</i> (Black-bean Aphid) and 1 <i>Brevicoryne brassicae</i> (Cabbage Aphid) recorded at this site.	
Strabane	Low risk: 1 <i>Metopolophium dirhodum</i> (Rose-Grain Aphid) recorded at this site.	

Key	LOW RISK	Low virus vector activity, no action required
	MODERATE RISK	Increased vigilance and monitoring of aphid populations required
	HIGH RISK	Severe risk of PVY transmission by aphids
