**Appendix D – Allocation Of Number Ranges For Slopes (Structure type prefix SL)**

00000 to 09999	None	Not allocated	Not available. Reserved for future use.	
10000 to 19999	10000 to 19999	New Northern	Available to Division	Existing records have a three digit number unique within the Division. This is to be prefixed by “1” and a further digit to provide the five digit number for future records.
20000 to 29999	20000 to 29999	New Eastern	Available to Division	Existing records have a three digit number unique within the Division. This is to be prefixed by “2” and a further digit to provide the five digit number for future records.
30000 to 39999	30000 to 39999	New Northern	Available to Division	Existing records have a three digit number unique within the Division. This is to be prefixed by “3” and a further digit to provide the five digit number for future records.
40000 to 49999	40000 to 49999	New Southern	Available to Division	Existing records have a three digit number unique within the Division. This is to be prefixed by “4” and a further digit to provide the five digit number for future records.
50000 to 59999	50000 to 59999	New Southern	Available to Division	Existing records have a three digit number unique within the Division. This is to be prefixed by “5” and a further digit to provide the five digit number for future records.
60000 to 69999	60000 to 69999	New Western	Available to Division	Existing records have a three digit number unique within the Division. This is to be prefixed by “6” and a further digit to provide the five digit number for future records.
70000 to 79999	70000 to 79999	New Western	Available to Division	Existing records have a three digit number unique within the Division. This is to be prefixed by “7” and a further digit to provide the five digit number for future records.
80000 to 89999	None	Not allocated	Not available. Reserved for future use.	
90000 to 99999	90000 to 99999	New Eastern	Available to Division	Existing records have a three digit number unique within the Division. This is to be prefixed by “9” and a further digit to provide the five digit number for future records.

Notes:

By convention, numbers ending in four zeros (10000, 20000, etc) are not generally used, but there is no prohibition on using them.
