## Notes:

Not all numbers in any given range are used. For Gantries it has been the practice in the past to allocate numbers at 10 or 20 intervals along a route, starting the route at 10, so that any added items can be inserted with an intervening number that allows numbers always to progress logically along a route. Divisions may wish to carry on this practice in future.

By convention, numbers ending in four zeros (10000, 20000, etc) are not generally used, but there is no prohibition on using them.

DBFO Companies who require a number for a new high mast or gantry must request it through PPP Unit from the relevant Division.
