Purpose

This memorandum introduces the RSTA and ADEPT Code of Practice for Ironwork Systems Installation and Refurbishment.

Scope

This DEM is aimed at staff responsible for the design or specification of works involving the installation or refurbishment of ironwork.

Background

HA 104/09 provides advice on the installation and maintenance of chamber and gully tops. MCHW - Volume 1, clauses 507 and 508NI and Volume 3 – F Series, provide specification requirements and details for chambers and gullies. Road Surface Treatments Association (RSTA) and The Association of Directors of Environment, Economy, Planning and Transport (ADEPT) have collaborated to develop a Code of Practice, based on industry best practice, to supplement the existing standards with the aim of improving performance in this area.

The purpose of this Code of Practice is to provide practical guidance on avoiding early life failure and to achieve a high quality installation and a high quality repair. The risk of premature failure and the common failure mechanisms, arising from poor design, material selection and workmanship, are explained and such situations should be avoided.
