Citizen's Summary 2016

Programme Overview

The strategic aim of the ESF Programme 2014-2020 in Northern Ireland is to combat poverty and enhance social inclusion by reducing economic inactivity and to increase the skills base of those currently in work and future potential participants in the workforce. This aim is to be realised through the three thematic objectives of the 2014-2020 programme which focus on:

- Priority 1: Promoting access to employment
- · Priority 2: Social inclusion, and
- Priority 3: Skills for growth.

Through activity in each of its thematic objectives, the ESF programme aims to enable participants to access, and to overcome their barriers to sustainable employment. The programme also seeks to enhance social inclusion providing specialist, tailored training and employment support projects for people with a disability and to focus on households as a means of preventing individuals from disengaging from employment, education or training by improving their family environment. The delivery of priority 3 provides a key pathway for the delivery of a greater volume of higher levels skills to the Northern Ireland workforce.
