




#### DAIRY COWS & HEIFERS IN MILK (£/head)




#### DROPPED CALVES (£/head)




FINISHED SHEEP - Deadweight price (pence/kg)




FINISHED PIGS - Deadweight price (pence/kg)





BROILER CHICKENS - Liveweight price (pence/kg)
