Cattle throughput in local plants increased last week with 7,969 prime cattle and 2,429 cows slaughtered. Imports of prime cattle from ROI for direct slaughter increased by 63 head on the previous week to total 322 head. Direct slaughter cow imports also increased by 15 head, with 194 cows imported. A strengthening cattle trade in GB, saw 72 prime cattle and eight cows exported from NI for direct slaughter, bringing total cattle exports to GB during the year to date to 598 head.

The deadweight cattle trade continued to improve across NI, GB and ROI last week. The average price paid in NI for a U3 steer was 626.3p/kg and for a U3 heifer 627.2p/kg, up by 8.8p/kg and 9p/kg respectively from the previous week. The average price paid for steers overall strengthened 8.4p/kg to 615.6p/kg, while the average price paid for heifers increased by 9.2p/kg to 615.6p/kg. The U3 young bull price also reported a 9.3p/kg increase, while the overall young bull price strengthened 9.9p/kg to 604.2p/kg. The trade for cows in NI continued to strengthen for the fifth consecutive week with the average cow price up by 7.9p/kg to 493.3p/kg.

In GB last week all reported base grades strengthened week on week with U3 steers and heifers increasing by 13p/kg and 12.9p/kg to 668.1p/kg and 671.3p/kg respectively. In ROI the trade continued to strengthen for all types of cattle in both euro and sterling terms.

The sheep trade reported a decline in NI last week with the average deadweight hogget price declining 13p/kg to 677.9p/kg. The liveweight trade softened 6p/kg to 627.9p/kg. In ROI last week the deadweight sheep trade strengthened by the equivalent of 2.2p/kg to 731.8p/kg.

Last week in local plants, hogget throughput increased by 1,036 head from the previous week to total 7,623 head. During the corresponding week of 2024 8,238 hoggets were processed locally. Heavier carcass weights year on year have been a feature of the local hogget kill during 2025 to date, last week the average carcass weighed 23.6kg, an increase of 1.4kg from the corresponding week of 2024. Industry has reported a decline in demand for carcasses exceeding 25kg with some plants quoting deductions of up to 50p/kg for such sheep. Producers are encouraged to consider various outlets when marketing stock.

This week in local marts a weaker demand from agents of the export market was evident with the average price for slaughter ready lambs in Ballymena on Wednesday back 15p/kg week on week. Base quotes for R3 grading hoggets ended the week at 690-695p/kg with softer quotes received for early next week.
