Total cattle throughput in local plants last week declined by 338 head or three per cent to 9,491 head. Prime cattle throughput totalled 7,136 head, a decline of 348 head or five per cent week on week. Cow throughput remained steady with 2,095 head slaughtered. Direct slaughter cattle imports from ROI totalled 239 head last week, comprising 148 steers and 91 heifers, with 144 cows also imported. Exports to ROI for direct slaughter totalled 27 steers and one cow. No cattle travelled to GB for slaughter last week

The cattle trade continues to strengthen week on week across NI, GB and ROI with tight supplies in GB continuing to drive the trade. Last week the deadweight trade in NI for steers and heifers strengthened by 14.8p/kg and 13.2p/kg to 660.8p/kg and 660p/kg respectively. The average O3 cow price increased by 15.1p/kg to 555.5p/kg. Base quotes received for cattle this week indicate similar increases across the grades week on week. Quotes ended the week ranging from 642-660p/kg for in-spec U-3 steers and heifers, with just one plant quoting below 646p/kg. LMC is aware base quotes continue to lag behind the fastpaced trade, and producers are encouraged Average prices supplied by Ballymena Livestock Mart. to price around the plants.

A steady trade was reported for sheep this week in local marts with larger numbers passing through sales rings. Mid-week one of the three major plants offered base quotes of 705p/kg with the others remaining

steady at 710p/kg. Local processors in recent weeks reported a slacker demand for spring lambs from customers versus previous years. This week the demand for spring lambs improved with the spring sale in Ballymena

on Wednesday attracting a large entry of
