Last week prime cattle throughput in local plants totalled 7,943 head. This was the second largest weekly kill during the year to date and increase of 807 head week on week, as plants prepared for two shorter working weeks. From ROI, 385 prime cattle were imported to local plants for direct slaughter, the largest weekly consignment of prime cattle from ROI during the year to date. These cattle represented five per cent of prime cattle throughput. Cow throughput also increased last week with 2,269 head slaughtered. Of the kill,159 head or seven per cent were imported from ROI

A strengthening deadweight trade in NI last week saw the differential with GB narrow for the third consecutive week. A strengthening ROI trade also narrowed the gap with NI for the seventh consecutive week. In NI the R3 steer and heifer price strengthened by 14.4p/kg to 681.2p/kg and 680.6p/kg respectively. An R3 young bull was paid 667.5p/kg on average, a 16.1p/kg increase and the cow trade also strengthened last week albeit at a lesser rate than recent weeks, up 5.8p/kg on average to 519.9p/kg. Base guotes for cattle did increase this week, however industry has reported the trade has steadied in Prices supplied by Ballymena Mart. GB and in some local plants.

The NI lamb/hogget throughput last week also increased by 1.084 head week on week to total 6,838 head. An additional 6,270 head were exported to ROI for direct slaughter. The second largest weekly export level during 2025, as plants undertake production ahead of Easter holiday closures.

In GB last week a large kill, estimated at 292,567 head, making it the largest weekly throughput since week ending 14 November 2020, saw the average price decline 13.9p/kg week on week to 710.4p/kg. In sterling terms, the ROI price increased 21.4p/kg to 773.8p/kg.

Local marts witnessed a weaker trade for sheep this week with steady numbers available as lambs made their way to the market in time for Easter. Sales held early in the week attracted large entries as producers planned ahead for Easter bank holiday closures. In local plants, two of the three major processors reduced hogget quotes by 5p/kg and 30p/kg respectively, while the other remained steady at 710p/kg. Quotes have not yet been received by LMC for spring lambs.
