Prime cattle throughput in NI last week totalled 7,961 head, bringing the total kill during the year to date to 164,927 head. This was an increase of 2 per cent or 3,425 head compared to the corresponding period of 2024. Meanwhile, 1,727 cows were slaughtered locally last week, taking year to date throughput to 47,038 head, up 226 head or 0.5 per cent on the same period during 2024. During the first five months of 2025 imports from ROI represented the same proportion of the local kill as the 2024 period; 3 per cent of the local prime kill and 6 per cent of cows.

The deadweight cattle trade across NI, GB and ROI continued to soften last week for all types of cattle, with declines in the GB trade continuing to outpace those seen in NI, and so narrowing the price differential. The average steer price in NI declined 6.9p/kg to 660p/kg, with the R3 steer price back 9.2p/kg to 660p/kg, with the R3 steer price back 9.2p/kg to 664.6p/kg. In GB the average steer price declined 11.7p/kg to 666.6p/kg, bringing the GB price for this week to 6.6p/kg above that for NI but 0.3p/kg below the average for NI last week. R3 steer prices declined across all GB regions with declines ranging from 4p/kg in Scotland to 13.3p/kg in Northern England. Prices in ROI last week softened in both euro and sterling terms with a weakening exchange rate impacting the rate of decline in the latter.

Base quotes from the local plants ended this week in the region of 710-720p/kg paying up to 21kg. Base quotes of 680-710p/kg have been received for early next week with only one plant quoting at the lower end of the range. Steady numbers of lambs are available for slaughter in line with normal seasonal trends, while local marts this week have reported steady demand for export.

Last week 2,246 lambs were exported to ROI plants for slaughter, taking output during the first five months of the year to 105,827 head. Compared to 128,242 head exported during the corresponding period of 2024 this is a decline of 17 per cent of 22,415 head. Last year the month of May saw a GB buyer begin to purchase lambs weekly in NI for a period. During the past four weeks 2,512 lambs travelled to GB for direct slaughter, an increase of 37 per cent from the 1,836 head exported during the same period last year.

In GB last week the average lamb price was back 36.2p/kg to 716.8p/kg. In ROI lambs declined the equivalent of 18.4p/kg on average.
