


## MANAGEMENT NOTES:

- Conditions are forecasted to remain dry for the next 7 days. Though temperatures at night are forecasted to drop to around 0° at the weekend, which may affect soil temperature and therefore growth.
- Prioritise maintaining grass in the animal's diet. Walk grazing platform and turn out any additional suitable stock to graze. This helps establish a grazing wedge before grass growth rates and the average farm cover (AFC) increase.
- If aiming for a mid-May cutting date of 1<sup>st</sup> cut silage, re-calculate the application rate of nitrogen if needed. Do not apply slurry to silage ground for mid/late May cutting that are carrying reasonable covers of grass to avoid grass contamination at cutting.
